# 1659 MINUTES OF THE PLANNING ADVISORY & HIGHWAYS MEETING HELD ON 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021

#### 1661 PLANNING MATTERS

### (a) APPLICATIONS

The following planning applications were considered:

COOMBE DOWN FARM COTTAGES, BRIDPORT ROAD, BEAMINSTER

Demolition of existing dwellings and erect 1 No. dwelling and associated works.

Beaminster Town Council recommend approval, some concern had been expressed with reference to 'Gun Room' purely as a potential future security issue and suggested any reference be deleted from the plans.

Installation of external staircase and access door at first floor level of The Coach House and change door to window.

Beaminster Town Council recommend approval as there would be no detrimental affect on the area.

#### 1662 CORRESPONDENCE

### (a) Dorset Council – Handrail – Hogshill Stores

Correspondence received from the Community Highways Officer had sought members comment on the proposal to remove the damaged handrail in its entirety subject to risk assessment. Due consideration was given to the request however members felt a hand rail should be retained and would not recommend removal.

# 1663 PUBLIC RIGHTS OF WAY

No issues were raised.

Under this heading Cllr Cheeseman advised Beaminster Ramblers had taken the opportunity to walk the Millennium walks in and around the town with a view to revising the printed guidance maps to incorporate the ordinance survey maps making them easier to follow.

#### 1665 HIGHWAY ISSUES

### (a) Dorset Council - Temporary Road Closure

Wessex Water had applied to close Woodswater Lane from its junctions with North Street and Willow Grove to allow the laying of new water main. The works were programmed to commence on 15<sup>th</sup> February 2021 to 26th February 2021 between the hours of 7.30am – 5.00pm. **NOTED.** 

Under this heading Cllr Dawkins reported the further breaking up of the road surface at Prout Bridge and a loose manhole cover in Hogshill Street, the Town Clerk to report.

Cllr Beswarick drew attention to a blocked culvert at Cherry Tree Farmhouse and Cllr Turner drew attention to a land drain across the pavement at Hollymoor, these issues to be reported to appropriate team.

Under this heading Cllr Drinnan advised whilst the Community Speedwatch Team were not currently operating he could report the Police speed camera remained active resulting in 328 notices of intended prosecutions for speeding across Dorset, a significant number recorded on the A3066 in Tunnel Road.

**No Through Road sign at entrance to Fleet Street** – the Town Clerk advised she had received a negative response from Dorset Council due to the potential confusion at the junction with the A3066 for goods vehicles looking to use Fleet Street for access to the navigable sections of the road.
